EASTCONN administers the Early Head Start program in Stafford in collaboration with Stafford Public Schools. Early Head Start serves children, birth to age three, pregnant women and their families. Services may include:

- Weekly scheduled home visits that focus on your child's educational development and support positive parent/child relationships
- Opportunities for play group sessions with other enrolled families that support your child's play in a group setting
- Professional guidance on parenting strategies
- Support with accessing medical and dental care
- A newborn well-child visit by a health professional
